Curiosity (Engagement)

We will develop our curiosity through asking questions and sometimes discovering our own answers through researching ideas.

We will build our skills in empathy by listening to others, face to face and through stories thinking about feelings and emotions.

As mathematicians

As mathematicians, we will also be consolidating our number skills linked to place value and using this knowledge to compare and order numbers. We will be learning to multiple numbers by 2, 5 and 10.

As readers and writers

As readers and writers, we will writing our own versions of stories linked to the ocean. We will also be writing information about animals from amazing places around the world.

As scientists

As scientists, we will look at animals and humans and how animals and plants depend on each other and their different habitats. We will be classifying and comparing animals according to their different features.

As geographers

As geographers we will be using geographical vocabulary to discuss physical and human features of different locations including locations in Britain, under the sea and key landmarks in other countries.

As computing experts

As computing experts, we will be using code to control events (specify inputs, directions, turns).

As designers

As designers we will design, make, evaluate and improve a product (habitat boxes) mastering practical skills including joining, cutting and moving parts.

As artists

As artists we will take inspiration from the work of artists to explore sculpture and materials/techniques to create our own clay sculptures.

As musicians

As musicians we will be consolidating our sense of rhythm and timing and continuing to develop our bank of songs.

As athletes

As sports people we will be learning to catch and throw accurately and develop these skills by playing games.

As religious experts

As religious experts, we will understand how beliefs (Christianity) are conveyed through the use of religious symbols, understand why 'Church' is important to Christians and reflect on the things that are important in our own lives and compare these to religious beliefs.

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
