As writers	We will write and perform our own poetry, showing understanding through intonation, tone and volume so that the meaning is clear to an audience. We will then explore story writing using a balance of speech and narrative to build cohesion within and across paragraphs
As citizens	We will reflect on how friendship is about being honest and showing who you really are. We will build our confidence in our own abilities and look at strategies to help us push past doubts and insecurities.
As religious experts	We will continue to develop our understanding of the Islamic faith by comparing and contrasting our learning to other faiths and beliefs.
As scientists	We will continue to develop our understanding of life cycles, specifically focussing on birds, insects and reptiles.
As computing experts	We will develop our communication skills to advertise our new product design.
As historians	We will investigate the British history of chocolate and explore the journey of bean to bar.
As designers	We will explore a variety of chocolate based products to help us to design and make our own healthier version.
As athletes	We will build our batting, bowling and fielding techniques as we improve our team working skills by playing rounders. We will also begin practising a variety of athletic skills for track and field events.
As musicians	We will be composing our own rhythmic performances.
As linguists	We will continue to become more independent learners and risk takers. We will use songs and books to inspire our writing and language learning. We will be looking at the topic of jobs and focus on using the conditional tense. We will prepare the children with some key phrases that will be useful if they travel to France in the summer.
