Young Carers



The next Young Carers Awareness Day will take place on **Thursday, 31 January 2019**. The focus is on mental health.

They will be tailored for different groups and will provide an opportunity for everyone to contribute to the way emotional wellbeing and mental health support and care are provided for children, young people, families and carers.

Some facts and figures

There are, on average, two young carers in every classroom in every school in the UK. One of those carers will be having difficulties in their education because of their home situation

- 30% of young carers are under 10 years of age
- 65 % of young carers feel stressed
- 28% have experienced depression
