We wanted to give an update on our PTA funded projects following Mrs O'Brien's announcement regarding the Specialist Centre that will be built at Worpleston Primary in the autumn.

You will recall that the fundraising objective for our Christmas Fair this year was to pay for a planned expansion of the infant's playground. We raised an amazing £6,300 from the fair and this was allocated to complete this project. The building of the Specialist Centre means that the planned new playground area will be needed as an access route while works take place. Therefore, the expansion of the playground will be delayed until the end of the works when the centre contractors will complete the project for us. In the meantime, the junior playground markings that were to be a part of this project will be completed separately this summer as there is no need to further delay these.

Our fundraising for the rest of the summer term will be dedicated to supporting the exciting refurbishment of the library that is confirmed to take place during the summer holidays. We have two great events planned that we hope will deliver the majority of the funds still needed – our PTA May Social on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May and the Summer Circus Spectacular on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July.
