Amazing Adventures



Curiosity (Engagement)

Empathy

As we begin Year 1 we will focus on friendships and empathy and, along with our values, these will underpin our daily lives.

We will build our skills in empathy by listening to others, face to face and through stories thinking about feelings and emotions.

As mathematicians

As mathematicians, we will continue to work towards developing a knowledge and understanding of numbers and the number system. We will be looking a numbers in sequence and compare number using greater than, less than and equals to. We will also be looking at shape and measuring length and height. We will working on our addition and subtraction skills and learning about place value with numbers to 20.

As readers and writers

As readers and writers, we will be looking at fiction texts and finding out facts about British wildlife. We will be using these texts and facts in our writing and practise retelling and writing parts of the story using new skills such as adjectives.

As scientists

As scientists, we will be exploring materials and what they are used for and why. We will be exploring light and sounds and their uses and investigating magnets and how they create force.

As geographers

As geographers, we will Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom. We will explore maps of the world and link them to our holidays, looking a places we have been and how they are similar/different to where we live.

As computing experts

As computing experts we will be learning to log on to our new chrome books independently. We will be exploring drawing tools and how to use a combination of these and linking our computing work to maths by collecting and presenting data.

As historians

As historians, we will start by looking at big events in our life times such as family events and starting school. We will then explore events taking place around us, such as the gunpowder plot.

As designers

As designers we will design, make, evaluate and improve products through building rockets and vehicles. We will begin our cooking journey by practising preparing and weighing ingredients to make a Christmas treat.

As artists

As artists, we will be exploring different forms of printing and use of colour. We will use our printing to create space pictures and will be exploring the work of Wasily Kandinsky, using it to create our own masterpieces.
