
Term: Autumn 1 Long Term Plan Theme: Our Green and Pleasant Land

**Curiosity (Engagement)**

We will be encouraged to ask questions based around the history of our local area, linking how and why things have changed.

**Teamwork / Independence**

We will have opportunities to work in teams to research the UK's features and our local area. We will also have opportunities to work independently to create pieces of writing.



**Resilience**

We will continue to focus on becoming resilient learners. For example, we will be using a variety of computer software to investigate the UK.

**Empathy**

We will have opportunities to empathise with others that have lived in our local area and the UK both in the past and currently.

**As mathematicians**

As mathematicians, we will use statistics to find out information about the different regions of the United Kingdom and using our understanding of place value to deepen our understanding of Number.

**As writers**

As writers, we will be building on our understanding of sentence work to construct descriptive writing based on our surroundings.

**As citizens**

As citizens, we will visit the local area and have an understanding of how our area has changed over time.

**As scientists**

As scientists, we will be learning about rocks and soils. We will have the opportunity to carry out practical experiments.

**As computing experts**

As computing experts, we will be using a variety of software to help us investigate places and features.

**As historians**

As historians, we will be investigating the history of our local area and exploring changes over time.

**As designers**

As geographers, we will be investigating the UK, focusing on the human and physical features.

**As athletes**

In outdoor and adventurous activities, we will learn to work with others to solve problems. We will learn how to read and understand a basic map. As gymnasts, we will use different pathways, directions and shapes to create sequences.

As musicians, we will be composing phrases and improvising rhythms and sung phrases.
