The Curriculum

Thank you for coming and visiting the Year 3 classrooms this week. The children were delighted to show off their work and classrooms and it was so lovely to be able to chat to you informally. In English, the children have been deepening their writing using the text 'The Day the Crayons Quit' and tweaking some of the characters and using a wider range of vocabulary and deepening their understanding of conjunctions in their writing. In Maths, we have been continuing with our learning of Place Value (using a mastery approach). The children are getting used to challenging themselves and moving onto the next level of challenge as appropriate to their level of understanding. In Geography we held our first debate, exploring the pros and cons of changing our local environment.

Home learning

We hope the children are enjoying the homework passports, just a gentle reminder that they can bring in any evidence at an point and add that into their folders. We hope the children are reading regularly and logging these in their home school contact books. They must bring these into school on a daily basis and always on a Monday when they will be checked for **4** signed reads. In the home school book, there is not a space for signing on the weekends however you can always make a note in one of the other boxes or at the end of the page.
