



Year 4 PGL Visit

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to share with you that the Year 4 Marchants Hill residential trip will be taking place on Tuesday 5th – Thursday 7th May 2020.

The aims of our residential trip are:

- To try new things when encouraged.
- To enjoy new experiences.
- To show a willingness to overcome fears.
- To show the ability to stick at an activity.
- To encourage independence and teamwork.

Whilst we are there, the children will be able to take part in a range of activities including abseiling, archery, the Giant Swing, zip wiring and Jacob's Ladder (activities to be confirmed nearer the time). The activities are designed to be fun and they often push children out of their comfort zone. A qualified instructor runs each activity. Until we know the exact number of children attending, we will not know the exact cost of the trip. We expect it to cost approximately £270 per child but this will be confirmed after we have final numbers in the next couple of weeks.

This cost includes:

- Accommodation for 2 nights
- Travel to and from Marchants Hill
- Meals, snacks and drinks - most dietary needs catered for (a medical form will need to be filled in nearer the time informing us of any food allergies)
- All activities – which are run by qualified staff
- Evening entertainment
- Use of all facilities and equipment
- Insurance
- A 24 hour qualified first-aider on site

We will hold a parents meeting regarding the trip at a later date where we will explain the detail regarding groups, sleeping arrangements, kit lists and pocket money. Please pop in and see your child's teacher if you have any questions.

How and When to pay

This trip is run on a no-profit basis. We require an initial deposit to guarantee your child's place on the trip and then there will be two further instalments later in the school year. If you need any assistance with payments please do not hesitate to come and see Mrs O'Brien or a member of the office team.

DEPOSIT – £100 by Wednesday 23rd October 2019.

The next two instalments will be due in January and March.
