In English this week we have learnt all about non-chronological reports and what features they should include. The children have written their own report about the Great Fire of London, focussing on the houses, how people travelled and what help they had in 1666. Next week, we are going to continue writing non-chronological reports focussing on the houses, how people travel and the emergency services in 2019.

In maths we have been subtracting a 1-digit numbers from a 2-digit numbers using Dienes and number lines. Next week we will be working adding two 2-digit numbers and will begin to use column method.

In Science we looked at the suitability of different materials. We had some interesting discussions about why some products would be unsuitable, for example a chocolate mug or a football made of glass!
