As mathematicians	We will be revisiting and expanding our knowledge of multiples, factors, square and cube numbers. We will also investigate area and perimeter, linking both to real world problem solving and reasoning challenges.
As writers	We will be focusing on non-chronological report writing. Also, we will be writing Christmas legends.
As religious experts	We will explore the concept of light as a theme during Christmas and Christians' belief of Jesus as 'the light of the world'.
As citizens	We will be focusing on our own wellbeing and learning practical strategies that we can use in real life. We will also be learning about different types of families and what constitutes a healthy relationship.
As scientists	We will be learning about our solar system and how the Sun, Earth and Moon relate to each other.
As computing experts	We will be using Purple Mash and developing our coding skills
As geographers	We will be studying the continents of North and South America and comparing the physical and human features or different areas within them
As artists	We will learn how to use perspective in order to create landscape drawings and paintings of some of the parts of America we will learn about in geography.
As athletes	We will be becoming more confident swimmers as we visit Surrey Sports Park for our swimming lessons. In our school-based PE we will be developing our hockey skills and applying them into a game
As musicians	We will improve our harmonic development using doh and soh and deepen our understanding of harmonics
