In English, we are using our new text 'Tiddalick the Frog', which is a Aboriginal Dreamtime story. This week we are re-writing our own version of the story with our skill focus of correctly punctuated direct speech. Next week we will be tweaking the story.

In Maths, we have been multiplying and dividing by 1, 10 and 100. Applying our skills to reasoning and problem solving questions. Next week we are moving onto measurement but please keep reinforcing times tables at home as much as possible.

The school now have a subscription to 'Spelling Shed'. The children use their username and password to log in and play some spelling games. We have set the first list to be - words with the prefix 'IL' and 'IR', which is our class focus at present. This is just another tool you may wish to use at home to reinforce spelling.

Next week, we have our last session with Metro Bank, in which the children will be receiving their certificates. In an email to the school the staff at Metro Bank commented on how well behaved and engaged our children have been! Well done to all of Year 4!
