As writers we have written information about hedgehogs. We have used the features of non-fiction text such as a main heading, sub headings and topic words to write pages to make an information book.

As mathematicians we have continued making up our subtraction number stories using the words **first, then, now**, and are now using different representations. We have used the part part whole model and seen that the number sentence must always begin with the whole. A challenge for some has been to write the 2 different number sentences eg. $10 - 6 = 4$ or $10 - 4 = 6$.

In RE we have been learning about the Torah, the special book in Judaism. We have thought about how we treat things that are special using the British Value of respect.

As artists we have made tints and tones and then used those skills to paint an autumn picture.

As scientists we have talked about seasonal changes which has linked to the hedgehog facts and hibernation.

We celebrated St Andrew's Day today, thank you to those children who brought in their homework to share with us.
