Our Guided Reading focus for the past few weeks has been on the skill of summarising. We have been practising within these lessons and our English lessons how to re-tell parts of stories, focusing only on the key events of these. When you listen to your child read at home you could ask them to summarise what has happened on the page or the chapter that they have just read to further practise this skill.

In maths we have been investigating prime numbers. The children know that these are numbers with only two factors and have been using this understanding to check whether a number is a prime number. Knowledge of their times tables is hugely beneficial in this area of learning so any practise on Times Table Rock Stars or through other games would be fantastic.

In a couple of weeks, the children will be making Christingles as part of their RE unit. We would be very grateful if the children could bring in an orange to make one. They can start bringing these in from now!
