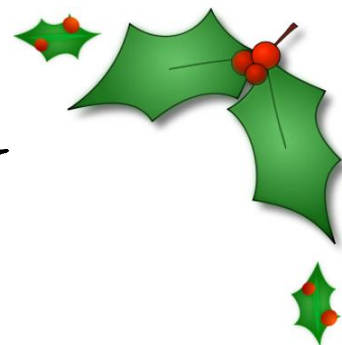

## CHRISTMAS

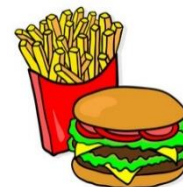
Well done to all the children who have done their Christmas productions this week, we are very proud of them all. We are now looking forward to the performances that are on next week.
