As mathematicians we have used tens frames and numberlines to show addition to 10 and to 20. Using these models the children were able to complete number sentences with missing numbers.

As writers we have used the story “The Storm Whale” to create our own stories. We aimed to start every sentence in a different way. The children have written imaginative stories over the last 3 weeks based on this text. We are looking forward to beginning our new text next week. Watch this space!

As geographers we have named and located the world’s oceans.

In Religious Education we have looked at why the bible is a special book for Christians. The children have heard the story of the New Testament and found out how the good news of Jesus was spread.

In PE we are learning to jump in different ways. We have counted how many jumps to ‘cross the river’ and have seen how far we could jump.

As scientists we have sorted animals into the different groups using the characteristics of mammals, amphibians, fish, birds, reptiles.

Please make a big effort to use Bug Club as much as possible this week. As teachers we get a weekly report on how it is all going and it would be fabulous to see this amazing resource being used well.

In computing we have used commands to program a “robot” – a child responding to instructions. This is an introduction to coding.
