Swimming

Just a reminder that the children's final swimming session is on **Monday 24th February** (the first day back after half term) which will be 'fun splash' so please can you ensure you child has their swimming kit so they don't miss out on the fun! Curriculum

In Maths the children have begun a unit on Measure and have been practising accurately measuring objects using different units of measure they have also begun to convert units of measure, deepening their place value understanding. In English, the children have been inventing their own version of 'Playing with Light' to include their new power source and setting! They have continued to use a range of adverbs in their writing as well as a variety of descriptive features. We have been so proud of how they have developed in structuring their writing.

In Science the children have carried out an experiment to determine if an object is magnetic or not. They will need to make predictions based on scientific thinking and test their ideas using fair test principles.

Home learning

The children shared their homework with their peers and class teachers. We were overwhelmed with the creativity and hard work the children put into their homework. Thank you for your ongoing support.

Just a reminder that within half term, you can continue to access the online resources such as Bug Club, Times Tables Rocks and Purple Mash using the logins in your Reading Diaries.
