G-Live Music Concert: Wednesday 25th March 2019

Rehearsals are going very well, but the G-Live concert is coming around quickly so I wanted to let you know about final arrangements for the day. Please encourage your child to continue practising (they should all have words to the songs and musicians should have their music). The orchestra and choir rehearsals at Northmead and Bushy Hill are coming up and information has been sent to you about these separately.

G-Live Information – Final Arrangements for the day

How do my children get to G-Live?

All the children (choir, orchestra and recorder) will be collected from Worplesdon Primary School and transported by coach to G-Live at 2.30pm.

What happens to all their coats and bags?

We strongly suggest that all children refrain from bringing coats and additional bags (apart from a small bag with their packed dinner and reading book) as it makes it harder for them to leave quickly at the end of the performance. The children can leave their school bags and coats at school.

What will happen when they get there?

The children will take part in a full dress rehearsal with all schools present in the theatre. The children will need to take a packed dinner (cold food only) and a drink and will have an opportunity to eat and relax prior to the performance at 7pm. Throughout this time the children will be supervised by Worplesdon School staff. Please provide your child with a reading book for this time. Please no electronic devices (ipads, mobile phones)

What should they wear?

The children should be wearing sky blue shirts, ties and their normal grey school trousers/shorts or skirts. We would like all children to wear a sky blue button up formal shirt (long or short sleeves) and tie. We would ask that you please provide the sky blue shirt for your child to wear on the day. These are available from Sainsburys/Marks and Spencer etc for reasonable prices. We have ties for all children which we will give out on the day of the concert. We suggest they do not wear a jumper as it gets extremely hot on the stage. Small red bows/hair ties/hair bands can also be worn. After the concert, please return all ties to the school office the next day.

What happens when the performance has finished?

You will need to collect your child from G Live at the end of the show, which will be at approximately 8.15pm. It is very busy at the end of the performance and we ask that you remain in your seat until our school is called before making your way to the foyer/stage area to find your child. It is important that you do this to avoid the rush that has taken place in previous years. If you are waiting in the foyer to collect your child, please remain there rather than attempt to come into the hall. ***Please ensure you notify a member of Worplesdon School staff before taking your child.***

Please remember that tickets are still available from the G-live box office. We need each concert to be a sell out for us to be able to continue this amazing event so please encourage relatives too! Thank you for your continued help and support.
