As you will know, in English the children have been using the poem 'The Listeners' as a basis to write their own narrative using this as inspiration. The writing has been fabulous and it's been really good to see children developing their own insight into what the poem means to them.

In Maths, the children have been developing their understanding of shape and angles. In some cases, the children have found the vocabulary difficult to remember. We have reminded them to use their revision guides as a support tool and to perhaps create a maths dictionary with visual reminders that they can use in the future.

As always, please keep listening to your child reading as well as encouraging them to visit Times Tables Rockstars to apply their tables knowledge.
