Dear Parents / Carers,

All the Year 4 staff would like to start by saying how proud we are of all the children for how they have settled into using Google Classroom. We have been impressed by the work they have produced and how they are demonstrating excellent learning behaviours. As a staff, we are continually developing the work we set with home learning in mind. We have tried to set an English, Maths and spelling task for each day, as there would be in school, and a variety of foundation subject tasks should you want them. However, we are aware that it is a challenging time for all involved so please note that we do not expect every child to complete every daily activity and we encourage other creative, outdoor or family activities.

As well as this, there have been some issues with uploading photos and extra attachments and we have uploaded a few help sheets to support with this. Please do not worry if you are still having trouble with this. In these cases feel free to email the work to the class teacher or hold onto it and just put a comment in the box so we are aware that it has been done.

As you will know, in English the children have been researching and writing their own non-chronological report about Iceland. They have been focusing on subheadings and paragraphs. Next week they will be able to choose their own European country to research and write about.

In Maths, the children have been continuing to explore decimals and their relationship to fractions. Next week we will be moving onto money. This will give them a chance to apply their knowledge of decimals in a different context.

In an effort to ensure regular reading continues at home, we have uploaded a weekly structure which may help when reading with you child. The structure is similar to what the children would be doing at school. Please use this resource if you wish, which can be tailored to any books that your child is reading.
