Dear Parents / Carers,

All the Year 3 staff would like to start by saying how proud we are of all the children for how they have settled into using Google Classroom. We have been very impressed by the work they have produced and how they are demonstrating excellent learning behaviours. In addition, a huge thank you to the parents and carers for their patience and support as we all navigate the online learning platform together.

As a staff, we are continually developing the work we set with home learning in mind. We have tried to set an English, Maths and foundation subject task for each day, as there would be in school as well as providing Guided Reading structure to enable daily reading to continue. The structure is similar to what the children would be doing at school. Please use this resource if you wish, which can be tailored to any books that your child is reading. However, we are aware that it is a challenging time for all involved so please note that we do not expect every child to complete every daily activity and we encourage other creative, outdoor or family activities.

As well as this, there have been some issues with uploading photos and extra attachments and we have uploaded a few help sheets to support this. Please do not worry if you are still having trouble with this. In these cases feel free to email the work to the class teacher or hold onto it and just put a comment in the box so we are aware that it has been done.

In English, the children have been writing a tweaked version of 'Mega City' using the video clip to support them. They have been tasked with changing the setting to a beach scene but maintaining use of fronted adverbials as that is their skill focus. In Maths, the children have been practising column multiplication. There are resources and videoclips on the classroom site and Mrs Woodruff has made a video to model the strategy we are teaching the children, this is available on the front page of the classroom. We encourage the children to use the answer sheet (after they have finished) so they can self mark and correct any errors themselves.
