In Maths, the children have been amazing us with their confidence in equivalent fractions and have demonstrated their understanding through their use of mathematical vocabulary in their answers.

It was great to see so many children tackle the Science experiment and we saw some great results! In Geography, we challenged the children to create a map of their home or garden and identify the human and physical aspects. As part of their Learning for Life, the children discovered more about the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. We hope you enjoyed the meal that the children prepared for you as part of their DT learning of preparing meals hygienically. All the meals, sandwiches and cakes looked fantastic!
