We wanted to just remind you to check the Year 3 Stream every day as that is where messages from teachers will be posted, hopefully the Weekly Learning Overview is helping to create structure in your daily learning at home.

In English, the children have continued their learning of conjunctions, with a view to using more challenging conjunctions in their writing. They have designed a new scene for their character and this week will be writing the narrative in the new setting. In Maths, the children have been ordering and carrying out operations with fractions.

In Science this week we have begun a new unit based on Light so the content was about what the children already knew and what they wanted to know. In Geography, we challenged the children to observe the wildlife in their garden and record what they saw. As part of their DT curriculum, we continued with the life skills theme and encouraged the children to bake some cookies, we hope you all enjoyed them together! In Computing this week, we introduced 2Sequence in Purple Mash where the children could be creative and learn how to make music digitally.

As a reminder, it is very important to press 'Hand in' or 'Turn in' when they want to upload work. Also, for the children to see the feedback from their teachers and potential house points they may have earned, they will need to click back into the assignments they have handed in.
