Dear Parents / Carers,

We hope that you are keeping safe and well. As before, please see below for some information on what we have been doing this week in Year 3. We have really enjoyed meeting up with some of the children this week in Google Meet sessions and hope to continue this on a weekly basis.

In English, the children have been looking at Poetry and specifically creating their own acrostic poems, this allows them to use other areas of English in their writing (adjectives, similes and description). In Maths, the children have been deepening their understanding of properties of shape and more specifically 2D and 3D shape. We have focussed on the language and vocabulary to ensure they can reason with the knowledge they have.

In Science this week we have continued our light unit and the children have been creating posters about the importance of eye protection. In Art this week, the children have been learning about Matisse and were tasked with coming up with a piece of work influenced by his style. In their Learning for Life session, the children have been asked to review our school drivers and consider how these are being implemented at home. In P.E we wanted the children to continue to remember the rules of fair play and how these can be carried out in the games they can play at home.

As a reminder, it is very important to press 'Hand in' or 'Turn in' when they want to upload work. Also, for the children to see the feedback from their teachers and potential house points they may have earned, they will need to click back into the assignments they have handed in.
