Welcome back everyone! We hope that you have had a lovely week off and enjoyed spending time with your families and enjoying the lovely weather.

This week we have been continuing with our learning of Time in Maths and focusing on telling the time to the nearest minute. We have also been learning about calendar months and years. In English, we have been looking at different grammatical structures this week and focusing on reviewing some of our learning from during the year. This has included homophones, prefixes and suffixes. In the foundation subjects we have been continuing with our unit topic of Light and trying to explain how shadows are formed. In P.E. we have been designing our own obstacle course.

We hope to begin Google Meet sessions next week, just a reminder that the messages pertaining to these meetings will be on the Year Group Stream and children must have an adult in the room. These may not be the same day/time each week, due to staff commitments in school.

Next week, we are planning to teach our RSE (Relationship and Sex Education) unit as part of our Learning for Life curriculum. This is going to be based around how our bodies change as we get older. Just to reassure you, the content of this session is extremely age appropriate and focuses on changes such as emotions, hormones and some physical changes. We will share the PowerPoint on Sunday evening, the same time as the weekly email and overview. We encourage you to look at this beforehand and analyse how you would like to approach this with your child. As always, if your child is in the in school setting and you feel like this would be an inappropriate topic for your child to learn about, please email the school office or bubble teacher.

We also wanted to make you aware that in the next few weeks we are hoping to teach a Design and Technology unit based on Photo Frames. We understand that everyone will have different resources available at home, over the next few weeks we thought it would be a great idea if you could begin to collate a bundle of resources such as cardboard/cereal boxes, plastic bottles, tissue paper etc. Thank you for your support with this.
