We have had another busy week in Year 3 and the children, both in school and at home, have been working hard on all their core and foundation subjects.

This week we have been deepening our understanding of telling the time by looking at the concepts of AM and PM. We have also explored how we tell the time differently on analogue and digital clocks. In English, we have been learning about a new tense - the past perfect tense. In our written work, we have been using a report about the Tyrannosaurus Rex and using the style to replicate the writing. In the foundation subjects we have been designing Stone Age clothing in History and learning how to treat others in Learning for Life. Last Friday, Miss Baynes hosted a whole year group Music session, which she plans to continue this term, please keep an eye out on the stream to find the link for the Google Meet sessions. The children who attended last week thoroughly enjoyed the session.

Just a reminder that in the next few weeks we are hoping to teach Design and Technology. We aim for the children to design and build a photo frame for practical use.
