Dear Parents / Carers,

We would like to say a huge thank you for your continued support and effort with all of the home learning. We just wanted to take this opportunity to remind you that last week we sent out a tip sheet with some helpful advice to support your child/ children through these last few weeks of term. While all of the home learning is happening we also have two bubbles in Year 3 (Lime and Green) which are being staffed full time by Miss Bennett, Mr Bowers, Miss Connor and Mrs Buck. As a result of this, Sparrows and Starlings may not receive feedback specifically from their teacher. However; we are very lucky to have an amazing team in Year 3 so your child may receive feedback from Mrs Herzig, Mrs Hopkins, Mrs Nightingale and Mrs Woodruff. It is our priority that ALL children and families in Year 3 receive quality feedback and support with their learning.

This week in Maths, we have started our unit on mass and capacity. The children have explored measuring in grams and kilograms as well as adding and subtracting using these units of measure. In English, we have looked at improving our sentences, answered comprehension questions about a text and created our own poems themes on a specific habitat. In the Foundation subjects we have revisited how mountains are formed, created volcano artwork linked to our geography, made some delicious cupcakes linked to our maths and discussed democracy in our society.

We have also had lots of Scavenger hunts take place to celebrate the winning houses! Well done to everyone for your continued effort and resilience and keep earning those house point!

Just another reminder that in the next few weeks we are hoping to teach Design and Technology. We aim for the children to design and build a photo frame for practical use. If you could begin/continue to collate a bundle of resources such as cardboard/cereal boxes, newspaper, plastic bottles, tissue paper etc that would be fantastic.

This week, we have begun live lessons which we hope to do on a weekly basis. More information regarding timings will be on the weekly overview. We hope that these sessions supplement the resources in the classroom including the videos and enable you to support your child with the lesson delivery at home.
