This week in Maths, we have continued our learning of measure with a focus on capacity and volume, the children have enjoyed carrying out real life maths using different containers to measure capacity and volume. A huge thank you to those children that joined the live maths lessons this week! In English, we have been inspired by the 500 words competition to create our own narratives based on an idea of our choice. In the Foundation subjects, we have started a unit on the Victorian era. Our first lesson was based on learning some key facts about the era and then we explored the work of William Morris in Art. In Learning for Life, we have been practising a skill in order to build our resilience and in DT we have begun designing our photo frames.

We have also had lots of Scavenger hunts take place to celebrate the winning houses! Well done to everyone for your continued effort and resilience. Keep earning those house points!

Next week, we will be making our own photo frames in Design and Technology. There will be a video on the classroom, however we are encouraging the children to be as creative as possible and if they would like to make it using their own idea, that would be fine. The key skills to focus on are:

Selecting a range of materials

Consider using a range of joining skills.
