Dear Parents / Carers,

Well we are nearing the end of a very different academic year for the children in Year 3 (indeed everywhere). We are so very proud of how well they have responded to the challenges the situation has brought. They have continued to show resilience, positivity and enthusiasm throughout this time and they will soon have a well-deserved break over the summer holidays! Please see below some more information on what has been happening in Year 3, this week.

This week in Maths, we have spent some time re-visiting the four operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We hope that by revisiting these important skills the children will feel confident with these as they move into year 4. In English, we have used our History as inspiration and planned and written a diary entry as a Victorian schoolchild. We also spent some time revisiting how to include speech within writing. In History we learnt about Victorian schools which was very eye opening. We certainly feel happy that school is no longer like that! In Art, we learnt about Georges Seurat and the style of art known as Pointillism, we have been so impressed with all of the beautiful artwork the children have created.
