
# Year Group: 3 Term: Autumn 1 Long Term Plan Theme: Our Green and Pleasant Land

As scientists	As scientists, we will be learning about rocks and soils and using our investigative skills to understand the composition of different types of rocks.
As computing experts	As computing experts, we will be reminding ourselves how to stay safe online. We will use Purple Mash to develop our coding skills.
As historians	As historians, we will be investigating the history of our local area and exploring changes over time.
As geographers	As geographers, we will be researching the UK, focusing on the human and physical features and map making using a key.
As artists	As artists, we will be thinking about urban and rural areas to sketch and collage different landscapes.
