Dear Parents / Carers,

We hope you have had a lovely week. The children have had a fantastic week and are getting used to the expectations and routines of Year 3. They have enjoyed participating in their first PPA sessions, including learning French for the first time.

This week in English, we have begun our first unit on the text 'The Day the Crayons Quit', this unit will focus on the skill of using conjunctions to extend sentences. The children have read the text in class and have re-written the text using text mapping to support their understanding of it. In Maths, we have been focusing on place value and using different representations of 2- and 3-digit numbers. In our foundation lessons we have been doing Gym in P.E and begun our unit of Rocks in Science. We regularly do Learning for Life to ensure the children are able to talk about their feelings in a safe and secure space.

In Year 3, we teach P.E. on a **Monday and Tuesday so the children must come to school in their P.E. kit**. On a Monday, they will be participating in Gymnastics so will need to wear:

- Grey tracksuit
- Worplesdon P.E. T-shirt

On their P.E. days, we would expect them to come in wearing a grey tracksuit and socks and trainers so that they remain warm throughout the school day as some sessions may be outside.

Just a reminder, the children are more than welcome to bring in a snack for morning break. Could we politely ask that this is either fruit or vegetables. As mentioned, we are happy to receive emails if you have any questions or concerns, our addresses are as follows:
