SIME GALLERY

Sidney Herbert Sime 1865-1941, is an artist mostly remembered for his fantastic and satirical artwork. He lived and worked in Worplesdon from 1904 when he moved there with his wife Mary. After his death his wife bequeathed his 800 pieces she had to the Worplesdon Memorial hall trust. Since 1956, a gallery has been inside the hall; Worplesdon's little hidden gem, open 2 - 4pm Wednesday's and Sunday's by appointment only.

Those who have not visited before, may like to visit on the extended weekend of Heritage weekend 11th - 13th September 2020. Visiting for Heritage weekend will be Friday 11th September between 2 - 4pm, Saturday 12th September 10 - 4pm with a talk at 11am. Sunday 13th September 10 - 4pm with talks at 11am and 2pm.

In accordance with COVID guidelines the gallery visitors will have to pre book ¾ hour visits with a maximum of 4 from 2 "bubbles" at any one session.
