In English, we have been continuing our focus on non-chronological reports by tweaking a report about the Water Cycle. In Maths, we have begun our new block of work based on column addition. We are going back and ensuring that the children are secure with their learning from Year 3 (3-digit numbers) before moving onto 4-digit numbers.
