## A MESSAGE FROM MRS O'BRIEN

Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for continuing to support us to implement our new COVID-19 procedures and protocols. Alongside a governor, I continue to review our practices weekly to ensure the safety of pupils, staff and their families. In our review, we have been mindful of the stricter government recommendations and the significant increases in coronavirus cases in the UK.

### Visitors to wear mask when entering the school office

There are times when visitors and parents need to enter the school building. On these occasions, we ask that these adults wear a mask. If the adult is attending an essential meeting then they will be escorted to the meeting room where the mask can be removed as long as social distancing of at least 2metres can be adhered to.

### Parents, grandparents & childminders at drop off and pick up

We are aware that despite the community trying hard to adhere to our socially distancing measures, our school site has 'pinch points' which result in adults and children being less than 2metres apart. As a result, **from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> October**, we are asking all adults to wear a mask at drop off and pick up. This applies to those using Early Birds & Night Owls provision.

## FIGHTING THE CORONAVIRUS

Following Mrs O'Brien's letter on Wednesday, making you aware of a member of our school community who has tested positive for COVID 19, we would like to clarify how the decision is made on who to send home. Public Health England support the school in deciding who has **been in close contact with the individual who has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19)**. A 'contact' is a person who has been close to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 anytime from 2 days before the person was symptomatic up to 10 days from onset of symptoms (this is when they are infectious to others). For example, a contact can be:

- people who spend significant time in the same household as a person who has tested positive for COVID-19
- a person who has had face-to-face contact (within one metre), with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, including:
  - being coughed on
  - having a face-to-face conversation within one metre
  - having skin-to-skin physical contact, or
  - contact within one metre for one minute or longer without face-to-face contact
- a person who has been within 2 metres of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes
- a person who has travelled in a small vehicle with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or in a large vehicle or plane near someone who has tested positive for COVID-19
