This week in English, we continue our skill focus on Paragraphs. We have adapted our planning so that the children are pondering a new statement, Worplesdon is the best Primary School in Guildford, the children have come up with lots of arguments to support this statement and to build their paragraphs. In Maths, we have been looking at the skills of rounding and estimating and we had an assessment to conclude our unit of addition and subtraction. Next week, we move onto multiplication and division. In Art, the children were using cave painting techniques to learn about the Stone Age. In Science we are learning about the skeleton and how it supports our body.

Reading – the children are all bringing in signed reading books, which is wonderful. We ask that 4 signed reads are completed within the week, teachers will be acknowledging these reads on a regular basis.
