### **Curriculum**

English – This week we continue with our text - 'Leon and the Place Between', and this week the children will be innovating their writing by changing the setting and characters but still focusing on the skill of writing using imaginative description.

Maths – We are continuing with our multiplication unit and this week focusing on using the formal written method to multiply and divide using 2-digit numbers.

Foundation – We continue to deepen our learning about the Vikings. We have been improving our sketching skills by creating a Viking longboat and looked at maps to discover Viking homelands and settlements. In Science, we looked at what a plant needs to be healthy and unhealthy. Over the next week or two we will be learning about pollination.
