Curriculum

English – This week we continue with our text - ‘Leon and the Place Between’, it is our final week studying this text, so the children have been busy inventing their own character, setting and plot. We have seen some fantastic ideas, full of imagination and our skill of imaginative description!

Maths – This week, we completed our unit on multiplication and division and practised using a formal written method. We were so proud of how well the children used methodical thinking and reasoning to answer the questions.

Foundation – In Science, we have learnt about the parts of a flower that are used in pollination. Next week we will be using this information to think about the process of pollination. In Art we have created backgrounds for our Viking long ship sketches – we have been very impressed by your beautiful art work Year 3! In learning for life we thought about our actions and how these can have a positive or negative impact. Next week in learning for life we will be thinking about acceptable and unacceptable touch on our bodies.
