Long Term Plan Theme: African Adventures

Curiosity (Engagement)

We will focus on being curious learners and be encouraged to ask intelligent and thought provoking questions. We will also seek to ensure that we are engaged in our learning by going above and beyond with our work.



Resilience

As curious learners, we understand the need for challenge and through perseverance within each lesson we understand how resilience leads to success.

As mathematicians	As mathematicians, we will review and consolidate the key stage 2 curriculum and use problem solving skills to challenge ourselves with out of context problems.
As writers	As writers, we will be writing for purpose and considering language and audience. We will be creating persuasive travel brochures and writing narratives involving super heroes.
As citizens	As citizens, we will be developing our understanding of empathy and consider how to develop strong and lasting relationships with our peers and preparing for the transition to secondary school.
As scientists	As scientists, we will be learning about relationships and sex education. We will also be learning about light, how it travels, what refraction is and investigating prisms and how they affect light.
As religious experts	As religious experts, we will be learning about Buddhism, the eightfold path and the beliefs of those who practise the religion. We will also explore the Golden Rule and how we can all live together in one world.
As computing experts	As computing experts, we will use Purple Mash to explore the world of computer graphics, designing our own. We will also use Purple Mash to develop our skills in interactive applications.
As geographers	As geographers, we will explore the continent of Africa looking in depth at biomes, vegetation belts and climate zones. We will also explore life in Africa looking at human and physical features.
As artists	As artists, we will investigate African patterns and designs as well as looking at African scenery for inspiration. We will explore the skills and techniques of fabric painting with sponges and stencils looking at creating texture on material.
As athletes	As athletes, we will be honing our skills in tennis, cricket and rounders as well as broadening and deepening our expertise in the area of athletics. As part of our production, we will also be developing dance skills.
As performers	As performers, we will work collaboratively with the other classes to create and perform in our summer production using our singing, dancing, acting and overall performance skills.
