This may mean we need to ask parents to walk once more around the playground to maintain social distancing. We ask that children in Air and Earth are collected by 3.30 so please factor this into your pick up plan if you also have junior children to collect. Tuesday and Fridays are PE days and we ask that children come to school wearing weather appropriate PE kit on those days. Please could you also send a pair of named wellies in for your child. These can be stored on the welly racks outside our classrooms.
