Curriculum

English – In English this week, we have moved onto looking at the features of a non-chronological report. We started the week off in a very exciting way, by showing the children a video of a dinosaur that visited school over the weekend! To practice using the features of a non-chronological report in their writing, we have started off by writing about Toothless from ‘How to Train Your Dragon’, many of the children have absolutely loved this and thoroughly enjoyed writing their reports.

Maths – This week in Maths we have moved onto a new topic of length and perimeter. The children have been practising using a ruler accurately to measure lines and objects, as well as understanding equivalent lengths in m, cm and mm.

Foundation – During our afternoons this week we started off with PE and Learning for Life on Monday. We continued our badminton sessions with a focus on the overarm serve, the children had lots of fun attempting a rally with their friends. In Learning for Life, we focused on conflict resolution and how to be a good friend, which we thought was particularly relevant after such a long time at home for many. In Geography the children created a persuasive poster about a European country, in Art we continued to focus on Edvard Munch and in Computing we have continued our work on Spreadsheets.

The children all have access to Times Table Rockstar’s, Spelling Shed, Bug Club (Active Learn) and Purple Mash. Whilst we use some of these in our lessons, they all have fantastic games and resources on to support the children’s learning.
