Dear Parents and Carers of Year 4,

We have had another good week in school!

In Maths, we have been continuing our work on decimals, looking at dividing and multiplying with 1, 10 and 100. We will be continuing with this next week. We have included the link as a number of children have been asking how they can access it at home.

We have all started to make our chariots in DT. The children behaved so well and were able to follow their plans and use tools to make their models. We will finish and decorate them next week before they are brought home.
