### Curriculum

English – This week we have started a new unit of writing with a focus on drawing on all the Year 3 skills Our writing stimulus is the Tear Thief and the children have already impressed us with their fantastic writing.

Maths – This week we have been learning about the skills of telling the time and also reviewing calendar months and years. We encourage you to support the children with time telling at home using an analogue clock.

Foundation – In Foundation this week, we have been learning how to read others feeling in Learning for Life and In Geography, we have been using a map to identify different climates and environments and drawing properties that would suit them. Next week, we will be beginning Music in our in-class sessions.
