### **Curriculum**

English – This week we have continued with our unit on The Tear Thief and the children have changed the time of day, and therefore the reasons that children are crying in the story. We have been very impressed with their creative ideas! The children continue to impress us with their confident ability to use a wide range of Year 3 writing skills.

Maths – This week we continued learning about time, focussing on telling the time to 5 minute and then 1 minute intervals and then challenging them with calculating time durations.. Please continue to support your child at home by practising telling the time on an analogue clock.

Foundation – In our Foundation lessons this week, we have taught our first in class Music lesson and the children were fantastic at using instruments and their bodies to add sound to the poem 'The Sound Collector'. In Learning for Life, we have thought about how we can link feelings to colours and discussed different ways we can express our feelings, and the importance of this.
