In English this week, the children have been writing their own biographies of a character who has had to overcome a hurdle to reach their dreams. They have come up with some fantastic ideas and their writing has been brilliant. Next week, we will be focusing on and developing some of the skills that we have taught this year.

In Maths, we have had a week exploring angles. We went on an angle hunt and practised the vocabulary acute and obtuse. Next week, we will be moving onto looking at the properties of 2D shapes with a focus on different types of triangles and quadrilaterals.

As always it would also be really helpful if you could continue to practise the times tables up to 12x12. In school we use TTRockstars and a game called Daily 10.
