## MAE'S BOYCOTT YOUR BED CHALLENGE

As part of Mae's Brownie Charities Badge, she will be taking part in Boycott your Bed this evening to raise money for Action for Children - sleeping in an unusual place. Mae will be sleeping in a small 2-man tent on a cardboard mattress without the usual comforts of her bed. She had set a goal of £100 which could buy a bed for a child who doesn't have a comfortable place to sleep and she reached that goal last night. Mae is now hoping to raise £500 which could provide an immediate, one-off grant to two families who need urgent help to cover the costs of essentials like food, bills or baby items.

Action for Children help disadvantaged children across the UK, from before they are born until they are into their twenties. They are currently supporting children and families who have been hardest hit by the pandemic. Life was difficult for vulnerable children and their families before the pandemic, now things are even worse! For most of us, happier times are ahead but for children and families in desperate need, there's no end in sight.



Nine children in every UK school class of 30 are currently classified as living in poverty. Poverty has a devastating impact on children – its effects can last a lifetime but Action for Children are working hard to stop poverty and the pandemic from scarring a generation.
