In English, we have rewritten the story of 'The Koala who Could'. The children have been focusing on sentence structure, capital letters and full stops. Next week, they will be tweaking the story and changing the main character and the problem that they will face in the story. We can't wait to read what they come up with.

In Maths, we have been continuing to focus on the place value of the digits in two-digit numbers. We have used a range of representations and we will continue with this next week. We will also be using the less than and greater than symbols to compare numbers to 100. It would be great if you could practise number bonds to 10 and 20 with your children at home as this will help them in other areas of Maths throughout the year.

Please continue to support your child with their reading at home. We will be benchmarking and checking reads in diaries as the weeks go by. If you need any support with this then let your child's class teacher know.

Just as a final reminder, we will be taking the children out at break and lunch even if the weather is wet. Please can you ensure your child has a suitable coat each day.
