We have had an exciting week in Year 2 and the children really enjoyed our successful baking day.

In English, we have written our tweaked version of 'The Koala who Could'. The children have been really creative and have written about kangaroos, dingos and parrots. Next week, they will be writing non-chronological reports about the events of the Great Fire of London. We will focus on grouping our sentences into paragraphs.

In Maths, we have been looking at representing the place value of two-digit numbers, including partitioning numbers in different ways. Next week we'll be counting forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s. It would be great if you could practise number bonds to 10 and 20 with your children at home as this will help them in other areas of Maths throughout the year.

Please continue to support your child with their reading at home. We will be benchmarking and checking reads in diaries as the weeks go by. If you need any support with this then let your child's class teacher know.

We will be using paint and baking throughout the year so if you have a painting apron/large old t-shirt that can stay in school for when we do these activities. As well as this we will be making models out of boxes and bottles. If you have any that you are happy to donate we would really appreciate it.
