Year 4 have had a brilliant week this week.

The children have worked hard to write their own invention story using the structure of 'This Morning I Met A Whale'. They decided on their own setting and creature to write about and we were very impressed with their imagination.

In Maths, the children finished the unit on place value focusing on negative numbers and roman numerals. We looked at how roman numerals are used in everyday life, for example on clocks, as well as how we use negative numbers in real life contexts. Next week, we will be moving onto addition.

As the weather can be very unpredictable, please could we ask that children come to school with a coat every day. This would be really helpful to ensure children can have a run around and let off some steam outside, whatever the weather.
