Dear Parents / Carers,

It has been another busy week in Year 2 this week. One of our highlights was our re-enactment of the Great Fire of London! The children were really excited by watching the fire and they even had a go at making sparks themselves! We are looking forward to seeing what they experienced come through in their writing.

In English, we have been writing a diary entry as Thomas Farriner, who was the baker who burned the bread on Pudding Lane. The children have been trying to add in exciting adjectives to enhance their writing. Next week, the children will be writing diary entries from the perspective of Samuel Pepys, who buried his diary during the fire and is the reason historians know so much about that period of history.

In Maths, we have been using blank number lines and resources to add a one-digit number to a two-digit number. The children have shown great resilience with this. Next week we will be developing this further by using a blank number line to do subtraction.

Please continue to support your child with their reading at home. We have been benchmarking and checking reads in diaries as the weeks go by. If you need any support with this then let your child's class teacher know.

Lots of you have already brought in wellies for field shoes. If you haven't yet it would be great to have these in school as the weather turns so we can continue to have outside breaktimes. Thank you.
