Dear Parents / Carers,

What a wonderful week it has been in Year 6! Jays class performed their assembly with such confidence and creativity – a massive well done to them.

As a reminder, next week the children will be completing some mock SATs assessments. Over the course of the week, the children will complete Reading, Grammar, Spelling and Maths papers. These are absolutely nothing to worry about but will help us to assess the progress the children have made so far and inform our planning for what needs to be taught next. They will also help prepare the children for the types of questions they will encounter in the future so that they know what to expect. We will communicate with the children how they have done, as well as with you in the weeks following.

As the field is now turning into something resembling a swamp as opposed to grass, it is vital that children come to school on Tuesdays with a spare pair of shoes and socks to wear once their trainers have become caked in mud (the spare pair can just be their school shoes as opposed to another pair of trainers). Equally, on days where it is raining, it is also beneficial to have a spare pair in case their feet get soaked on the playground.

Additionally, on Mondays we are teaching the children gymnastics where the children are asked to take their shoes and socks off.
