ROADWORKS UPDATE

Surrey County Council Highways team have sent the following message in regard to roadworks and road closure at Fairlands avenue starting on 25th November:

To minimise disruption and maintain access to the school, the team intend to do the junction into Fairlands Road first. This section will be completed under the restricted hours 09:30-15:00. This will then allow access for the school via this section for the remainder of the works. The remainder of the works will be carried out during the normal advertised hours of 8am to 5pm and we will have a signed diversion in place with gate operatives to assist with any access issues.

The team are fully aware of the issues with the flow of traffic in this area and they will be working closely with the traffic management team on site throughout this scheme.
